

Sociometrics Social Science Electronic Data Library (SSEDL)

Perpetual License for <Name of college or university>

Congratulations on securing a permanent license to the Social Science Electronic Data Library (SSEDL). Your perpetual license protects your investment in SSEDL in two ways:

1. If at any time <name of college or university> stops subscribing to SSEDL, you will continue having access to the version of SSEDL that was active as of your last subscription year via a dedicated online portal provided by Sociometrics.

Note: The terms of your original license (Appendix A, unless your organization negotiated a tailored license for your university) will continue. No changes in IP addresses will be accepted.

2. If at any time, SSEDL access stops being available from Sociometrics or its designate, you will be informed by Sociometrics via certified letter. At that point you will have one month to copy all SSEDL data to your internal network for perpetual use and distribution to your organization.

Note: Usage and distribution rights will limited to the IP addresses specified in your SSEDL license. The perpetual license does not permit redistribution of the data outside your organization.

Appendix A. Sociometrics Social Science Electronic Data Library (SSEDL)

Institutional License

1. The materials available in the SSEDL and appearing online may not be reproduced, redistributed, resold or published elsewhere without written consent of: Josefina J. Card, PhD, President, Sociometrics Corporation, or her designate.
2. "Authorized Users" are authenticated, authorized current full and part time students, employees (including faculty, staff, and affiliated researchers), and other individuals who have permission to use the public computers on an Institutional Subscriber's geographically constrained site. A "site" is an organizational unit, and may be academic or non-academic. For organizations located in more than one city, each city office is considered a different site. For organizations within the same city that are administered independently, each office is considered a different site.
3. A subscriber to SSEDL may view, reproduce or store copies of datasets and information comprising the subscription provided that the data are used only for immediate educational or

classroom non-commercial use. Institutional archival copies are not permitted without express written permission from Sociometrics.

4. All individuals using Sociometrics SSEDL are subject to the Public Health Service Act that prohibits any effort to determine the identity of any reported case. Therefore users will:

- a) Use SSEDL data for statistical reporting, analysis and teaching only;
- b) Make no use of the identity of any person or establishment discovered inadvertently;
and
- c) Not link SSEDL data with individually identifiable data from other data sets.

5. The Institutional Subscriber is responsible for creating and maintaining reasonable security measures, and posting policies consistent with the rights and restrictions described in these guidelines to ensure that only Authorized Users can access the SSEDL. The Institutional Subscriber is prohibited from making agreements for access to the SSEDL with individuals, organizations, vendors, affiliates, or partners, which are not parts of the same institution purchasing this subscription. The Institutional Subscriber affirms that all IP addresses in the range listed for authorization are specifically controlled by the institution for workstations under its administrative control and for the use of individuals who meet the Authorized User definition above. The Institutional Subscriber is responsible for maintaining the list of IP addresses of all Authorized Users.

6. If the Institutional Subscriber becomes aware of unauthorized access to or unpermitted archiving of the SSEDL, it will notify Sociometrics immediately and cooperate in locating and attempting to stop the specific individuals who are abusing the service. If the specific abuser(s) cannot be identified or stopped, Sociometrics has the right to withhold, suspend, or terminate access to all or any portion of the SSEDL online subscription materials, immediately and without liability.

7. The Institutional Subscriber agrees not to remove, cover, overlay, obscure, block, or change any copyright notices, legends, or terms of use which the Sociometrics may post on the site in order to inform users about system features, terms of use, or copyright notices.
